Need to track your delivery?

Our couriers carry the latest handheld technology, so it's easy to keep track of your deliveries online with our parcel tracking system.



Step 2: Enter your parcel label number

Step 1: Visit www.fastway.co.nz

Step 3: Click **Track** and see exactly where it is, including a scanned signature on receipt.

If your customer isn't home, a card is left and re-delivery[#] arranged at no extra charge. If you prefer, you can give authorisation to deliver without a signature for specified parcels, or all your deliveries.

How much does your parcel weigh?

You'll need to know your parcel's actual weight and its cubic weight, as the delivery rate is calculated on whichever is the greater.

The cubic conversion rate is 200kg per cubic metre, so cubic weight = HxWxLx200.

In	Example: if a parcel is:			
H	Height:	80cm	>	0.8m
	Width:	50cm	>	0.5m
	Length:	15cm	>	0.15m

Convert measurements to metres.

- 2. Multiply the height x width x length x cubic conversion (200) to get cubic weight.
 - (H) 0.8m x (W) 0.5m x (L) 0.15m x 200 = 12kg
- So, if the actual weight of this parcel was 5 kilograms and the cubic weight was 12 kilograms, the greater weight of 12 kilograms is used to calculate the price.
